

AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR HEALING YOUR NEW TATTOO

*carefully following our detailed aftercare instructions is a very important part of healing your tattoo.

H2Ocean Extreme Tattoo Care Kit includes 3 unique products (soap/ointment/cream) designed specifically to ensure the efficient, comfortable & successful healing of your new tattoo.



DAY 1

- 1. Leave the bandage on your tattoo for one hour after your appointment is finished.
- 2. Remove your bandage & gently wash your tattoo with H2Ocean Blue Green Foam Soap using warm water & only your hand/fingers.
- 3. Pat your tattoo dry with a clean towel & leave uncovered for the rest of the healing process.
- 4. Use clean bedding to prevent the contamination of your new tattoo. *tattoo may seep onto bedding

DAY 2 & 3

- 1. Maximum 2-3 times daily, gently wash your tattoo with **H2Ocean Blue Green Foam Soap** using warm water & only your hand/fingers. Pat your tattoo dry with a clean towel.
- 2. Maximum 2-3 times daily apply a very small amount of **H2Ocean Aquatat Ointment** in a thin layer with your fingertips until it is fully absorbed.

DAY 4

- 1. Discontinue use of H2Ocean Aquatat Ointment & replace with H2Ocean Care Cream
- 2. Gently wash your tattoo with **H2Ocean Blue Green Foam Soap** using warm water & only your hand/fingers. Pat your tattoo dry with a clean towel.
- 3. Maximum twice daily apply a very small amount of **H2Ocean Care Cream** in a thin layer with your fingertips until it is fully absorbed.
- 4. Continue until your tattoo is fully healed. (Usually 6 weeks)
 - > DO NOT go into pools, hot tubs or lakes/oceans. Shower rather than bathe.
 - > DO NOT use hydrogen peroxide, rubbing alcohol, Polysporin or Vaseline.
 - DO NOT expose your tattoo to direct sunlight or tanning beds.
 - > DO NOT pick, scratch or rub your tattoo.
 - DO NOT over moisturize or apply any product other than the H2Ocean products recommended by your artist.
